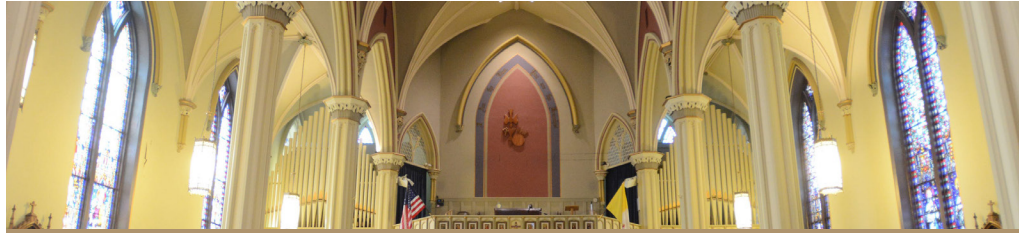

EVENINGS OF FAITH AND FELLOWSHIP:

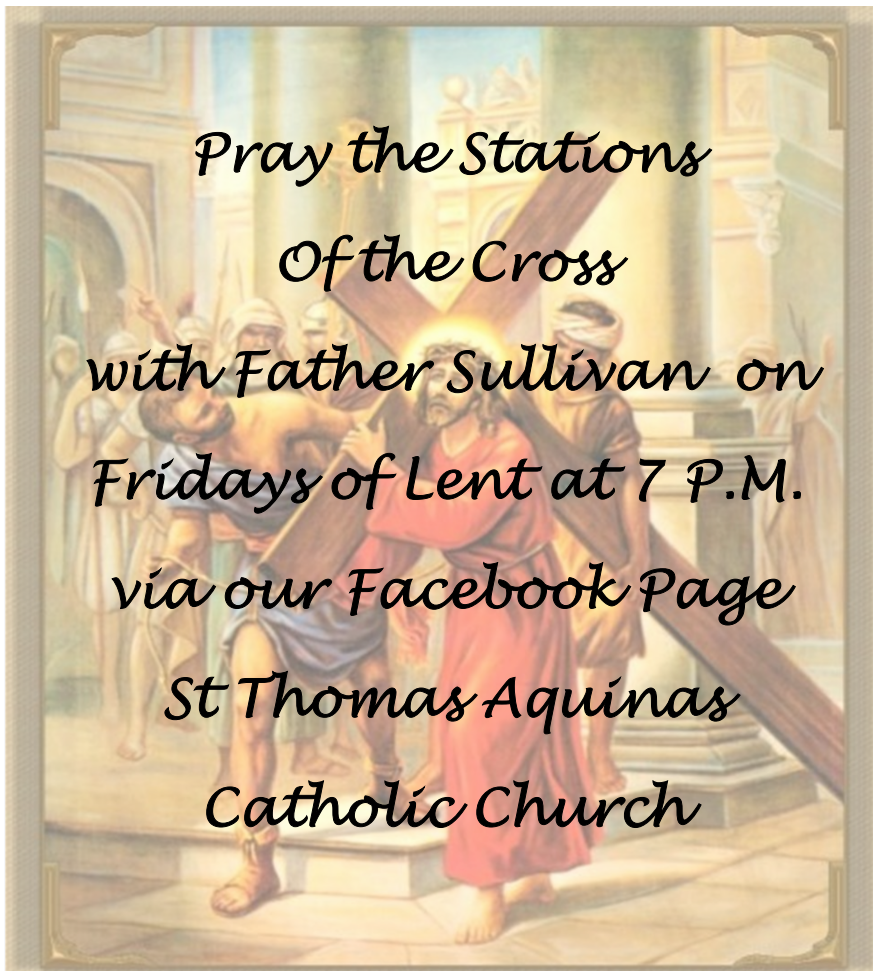

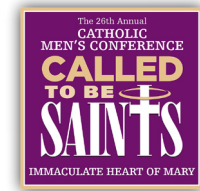
