



# ST. THOMAS AQUINAS ROOF REPAIR UPDATE

This week, crews will continue working on truss reinforcement in the church roof. The "Dance Floor" is now partially completed and can be seen in the photo as Steve Harding is inspecting the work. A "Dance Floor" is a work platform that will be used by the construction crew to install the steel C Channels that will provide the structural integrity needed to remove the physical load fom the current trusses. Reinforcement of the floor trusses is also underway.


