ROOF REPAIR UPDATE:

This week, we began the installation of a "trolley system" in the attic of the church. The steel C channels that will be used to reinforce the structural support, weigh between 70 and 350 pounds each. A system is necessary to be able to transport and handle the C channels during installation. That is the reason for the "Trolley System" which is shown in the pictures this week. A crane will lift the C channels to the doghouse on the roof. At that point, the trolley system will be used for transport and placement.


CATHOLIC MEN'S LUNCHEON:


