

ROOF REPAIR UPDATE

As part of the roof repair and renovation of St. Thomas Aquinas Church, there are changes coming to our pews and pew layout. The pews are being refreshed and restored and this is being done at a warehouse in Marne, Ohio. That part of the project is about 30% complete. An example of a restored pew is now in the Activity Center. Pew layout is also part of the renovation. In the past, the pews were flush against the north and south walls of the church. The new layout will create aisles next to these walls that are 3 feet, 6 inches in width. This will allow for better flow during Communion and easier access for seating. Also, a larger space is being created between the altar platform and the modesty panels. The distance is being expanded from 4 feet to 7 feet. Again, this allows for much better flow during Communion and reduces the chance of an accident. We expect the church to be able to seat 500 people when reopened.



CATHOLIC FOUNDATION UPDATE:
