CCD ENROLLMENT UNDERWAY:

Registration for religious education classes at Saint Thomas Aquinas is underway. Classes begin September 15th and are held on Sundays through May from 9:30-10:45 a.m. in the Parish Center for students in Kindergarten (five years old by September 30) through 8th grade. Students in second grade prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, while 8th grade students are prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation. You will receive confirmation of enrollment with further details approximately one week prior to our kickoff. Registration for Sacrament Preparation is included in the packet.


