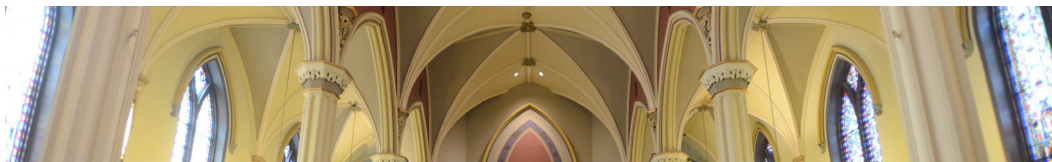

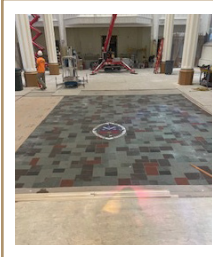

CCD ENROLLMENT UNDERWAY:

Registration for religious education classes at Saint Thomas Aquinas is underway. Classes begin September 15th and are held on Sundays through May from 9:30-10:45 a.m. in the Parish Center for students in Kindergarten (five years old by September 30) through 8th grade. CCD meets the faith formation needs of students in our parish who are attending public schools, non-Catholic private schools, or who are homeschooled – but everyone is welcome! Students in second grade prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, while 8th grade students are prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Registration forms are available at church entrance and exit doors or in the Parish Office. You may register all of the children in your family using this one form. You will receive confirmation of enrollment with further details approximately one week prior to our kickoff. Registration for Sacrament Preparation is included in the packet.

Fortunately, despite all of the heavy equipment and shoring towers that have been utilized, the floor remains nearly intact and free from damage! In this picture, the Dominican seal has been exposed, which is a remembrance of our long history with the Dominicans.

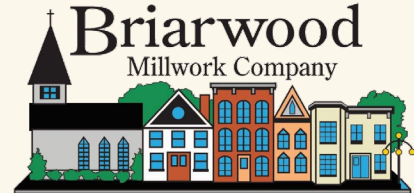

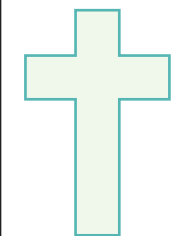
