



WITH GREATER COLUMBUS RIGHT TO LIFE

When: Monday, January 27th, 2025, 12:00-1:00 p.m. Where: Ohio Statehouse Atrium After the 10:00 a.m. Respect Life Mass. Celebrated at St. Joseph Cathedral by Bishops Earl K. Fernandez of Columbus and Bishop Daniel Thomas of Toledo.

Each year since 1973, Greater Columbus Right to Life and the pro-life faithful of Ohio gather on or near the anniversary of the U.S Supreme Court's sweeping decision the broadly legalized abortion.

On January 27th, 2025, 52 years since the passage of *Roe v. Wade*, we will again join in a time dedicated to remembering those that have been wounded or died at the hands of abortion in the past year, gathering in prayer and unity, and encouraging those who labor against the violence of abortion.
