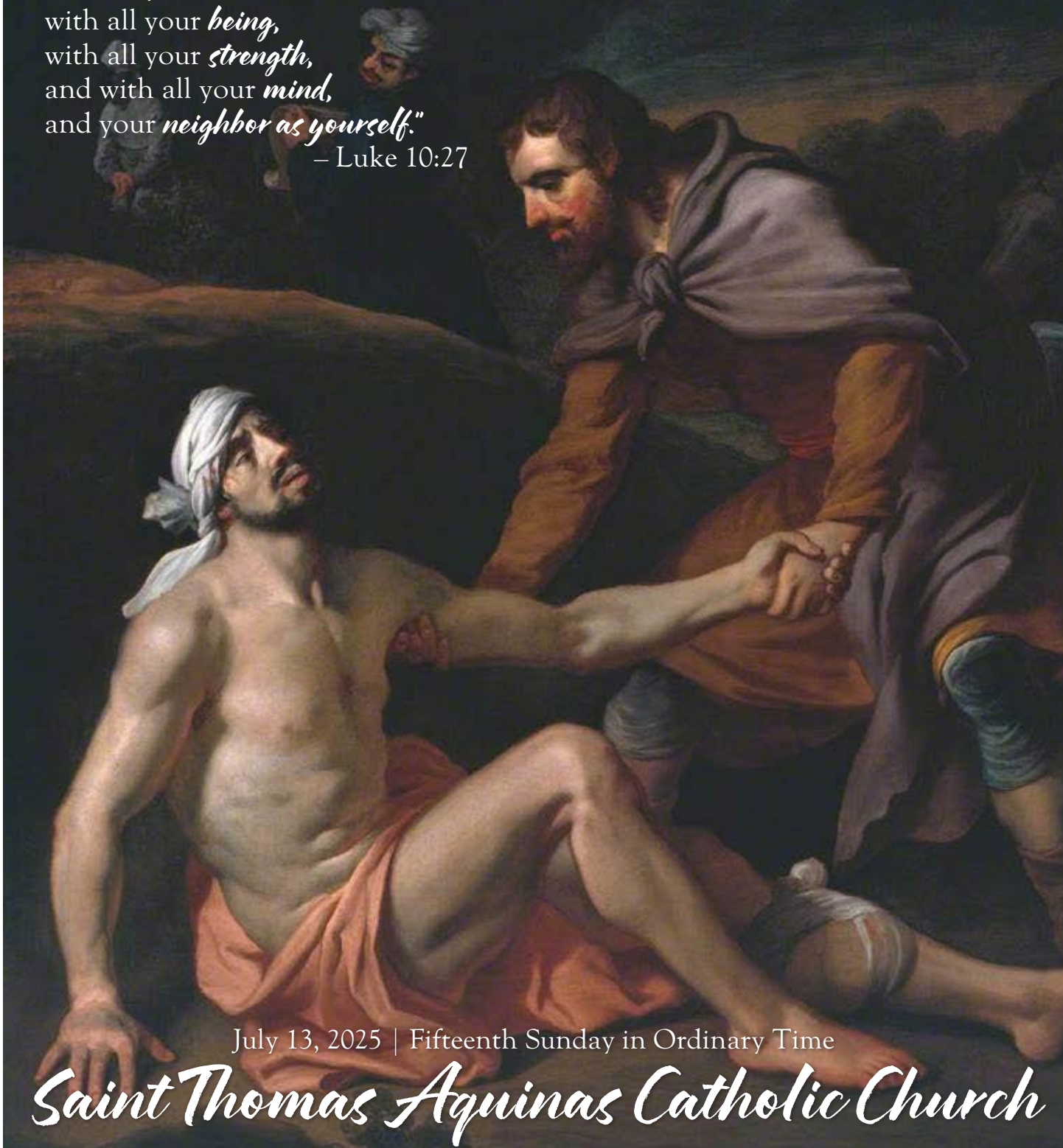

**MYSTERY OF THE EUCHARIST:**

**Tuesday, July 15, evening in Rosary Hall, 6:30 p.m.** – Watch the Augustine Institute's Formed program - *Presence: The Mystery of the Eucharist*. 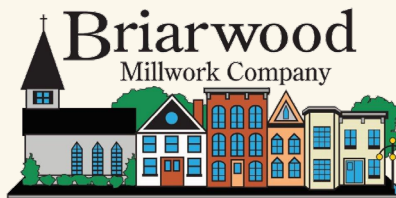

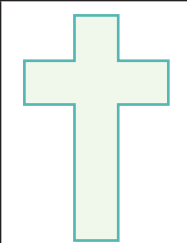
