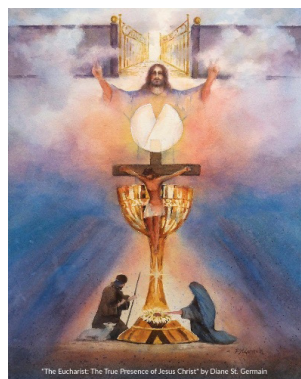

**THE CHOSEN – SEASON 1 & 2**

Set in 1st century Galilee, the first season chronicles how Jesus starts to build a group of disciples and His ministry. As He performs His first miracles, including turning water into wine in Cana, and invites people of various backgrounds to study under Him, Jesus calls the redeemed woman Mary Magdalene; the stonemason Thaddaeus; the choir member Little James; the fishermen Simon, Andrew, Big James, and John; the caterer Thomas and vintner Ramah; and the tax collector Matthew to follow Him. Following Jesus’ meeting with the Pharisee Nicodemus, the season culminates with the group traveling through Samaria, where Jesus launches public ministry after revealing to Photina, a Samaritan woman.

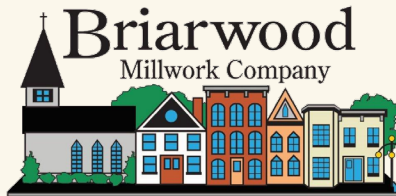

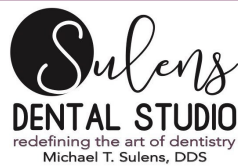

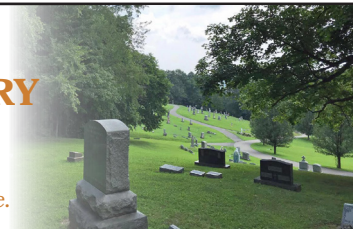
