

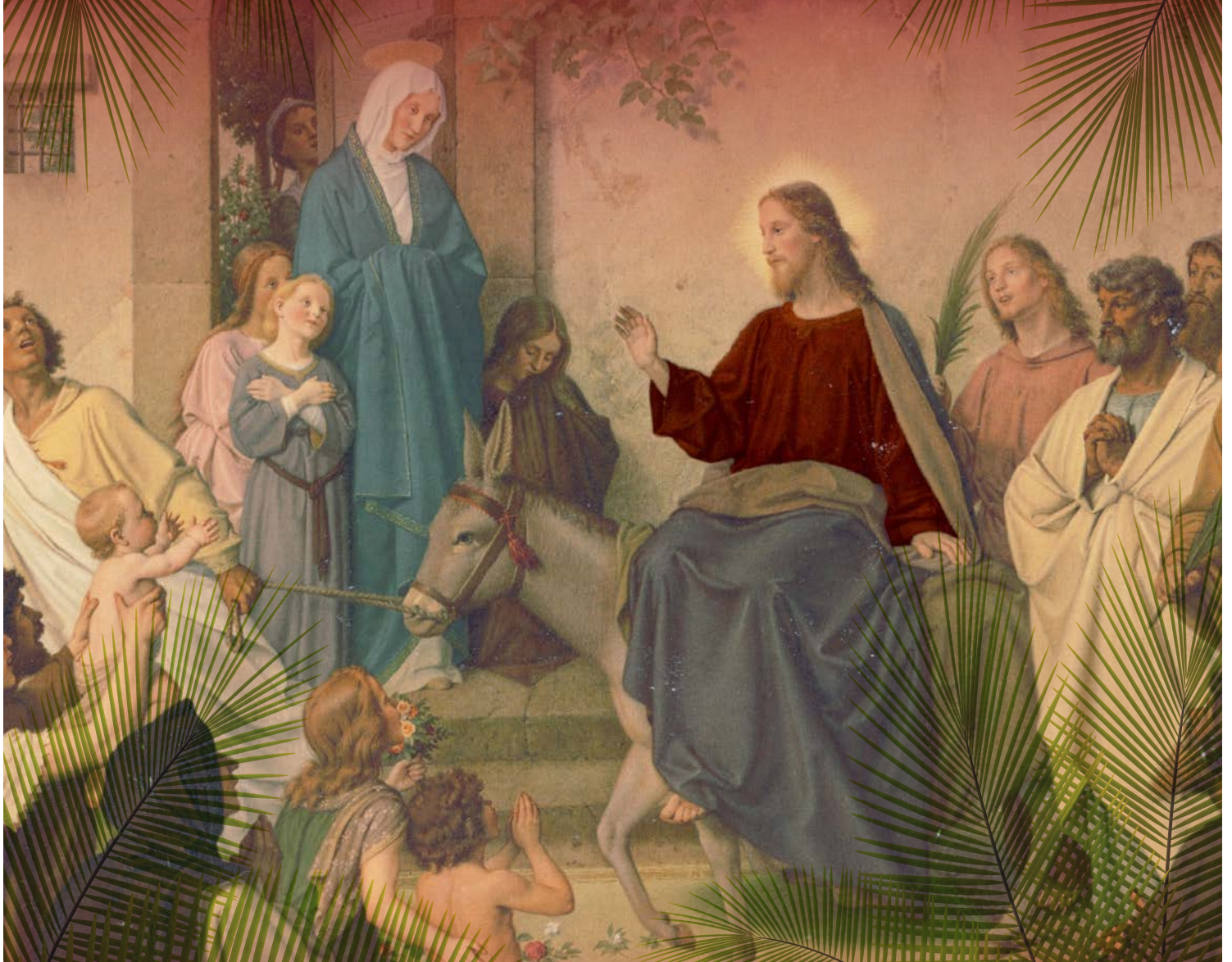

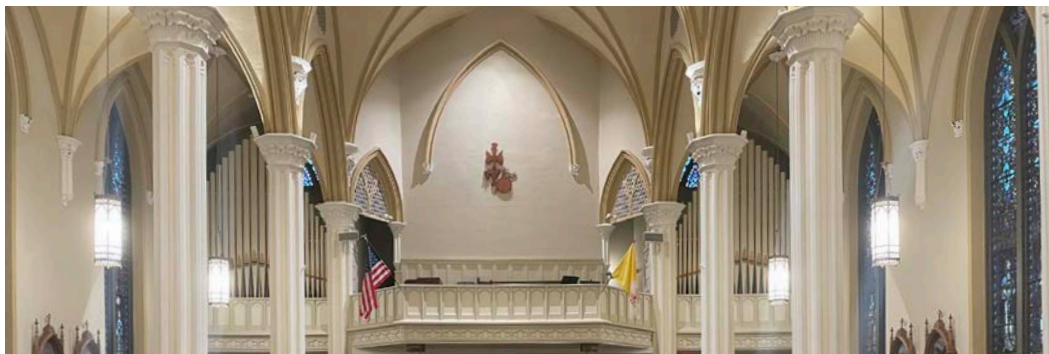

PIVOTAL PLAYERS PREMIERE SESSIONS

St. Thomas Aquinas – The Theologian. The relationship of faith and reason is under intense scrutiny in an age beholden to the competing claims of fundamentalism and secularism. So-called “new atheists” insist that the claims of religion amount to mere superstition, a retrograde holdover from a time long ago. Others insist that the life of faith is a retreat into emotions and subjectivism. St. Thomas Aquinas anticipated these objections and trends and demonstrated that to believe is to think and that the life of the mind is integral to life in Christ.

THE CHOSEN – SEASONS 1 & 2

Set in the 1st century Galilee, the first season chronicles how Jesus starts to build a group of disciples and His ministry. As He performs His first miracles, including turning water into wine in Cana, and invites people of various backgrounds to study under Him, Jesus calls the redeemed woman Mary Magdalene; the stonemason Thaddaeus; the choir member Little James; the fishermen Simon, Andrew, Big James, and John; the caterer Thomas and vintner Ramah; and the tax collector Matthew to follow Him. Following Jesus’ meeting with the Pharisee Nicodemus, the season culminates with the group traveling through Samaria, where Jesus launches public ministry after revealing to Photina, a Samaritan woman.

THE VATICAN NEWS FEED

We'd like to draw your attention to a new item on the Diocese of Columbus website (<https://columbuscatholic.org/>), the Vatican News Feed. Bishop Fernandes has worked with the Dicastery of Communications in Rome and the Catholic Foundation to be able to provide this free news service to the Diocese of Columbus. The Vatican feed is divided into three parts and will contain: 1) Videos constantly and automatically updated featuring Pope Leo XIV, 2) A news ticker about the pope, the Holy See, and the universal Church, constantly and automatically updated, 3) The link to access vatican.va, the official website of the Holy See with the pope's full texts. The feed features articles with reports on the pope and on the main events that take place in Rome and in the Universal Church, but also a number of materials that can be used for pastoral work, education, and prayer. This service will thus make it possible to strengthen the communion of American dioceses and parishes as well as all the diocese and parishes worldwide wide with the Successor of Peter, a pressing need especially today in the era of fake AI-generated content. The Vatican considers this initiative important and urgent also in view of the fact that the Pontiff's mother tongue is English and, for the first time in history, the pastor of the Universal Church is a citizen of the United States. You may have already noticed the feed on both the Diocese of Columbus and *The Catholic Times* websites.

REFLECTION ON MATTHEW 26:14—27:66

The Palm Sunday liturgy begins on the upbeat, with Jesus’ triumphant entry into Jerusalem, but dissolves into mayhem as the Passion story unfolds. By hearing today the entire Passion story of Jesus, we are invited to enter into the holiest week of the year, when we will hear and celebrate the same story in its essential parts as we move through Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday.

As we give thanks for God’s mercy embodied in Jesus and His great gift of Self, we are invited into the story, to allow Jesus’ suffering, death and Resurrection to interpret our lives. There is much here to pause with and reflect on: friendship and betrayal, our personal depths of sinfulness and violence, fear and social pressure, greed and lust for power. As we take ownership of our need for redemption, our individual stories merge with the story of Jesus. We walk the same path together, through death to new life.

SAINT OF THE DAY

Saint Isidore of Seville

Saint of the Day: April 4

Patron Saint of the Internet

The 76 years of Isidore's life were a time of conflict and growth for the Church in Spain. Spain was split in two: One people (Catholic Romans) struggled with another (Arian Goths). Saint Isidore of Seville reunited Spain, making it a center of culture and learning. The country served as a teacher and guide for other European countries whose culture was also threatened by barbarian invaders.

Born in Cartagena, Saint Isidore of Seville was educated by his elder brother, whom he succeeded as bishop of Seville.

An amazingly learned man, he was sometimes called "The Schoolmaster of the Middle Ages" because the encyclopedia he wrote was used as a textbook for nine centuries. He required seminaries to be built in every diocese, wrote a Rule for religious orders, and founded schools that taught every branch of learning. Isidore wrote numerous books, including a dictionary, an encyclopedia, a history of Goths, and a history of the world—beginning with creation! He completed the Mozarabic liturgy, which is still in use in Toledo, Spain.

Saint Isidore of Seville continued his austerities even as he approached age 80. During the last six months of his life, he increased his charities so much that his house was crowded from morning till night with the poor of the countryside.

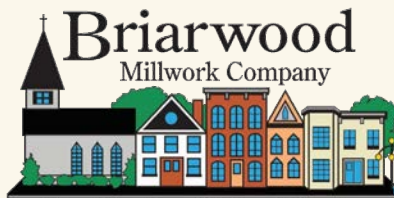

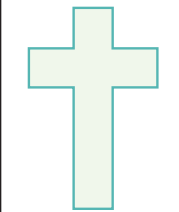
