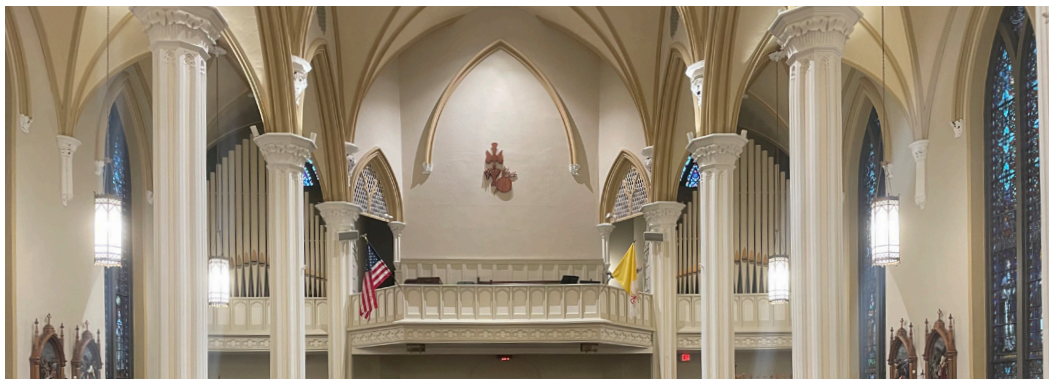

**PIVOTAL PLAYERS PREMIERE SESSION**

*St. Thomas Aquinas – The Theologian.* The relationship of faith and reason is under intense scrutiny in an age beholden to the competing claims of fundamentalism and secularism. So-called “new atheists” insist that the claims of religion amount to mere superstition, a retrograde holdover from a time long ago. Others insist that the life of faith is a retreat into emotions and subjectivism. St. Thomas Aquinas anticipated these objections and trends and demonstrated that to believe is to think and that the life of the mind is integral to life in Christ.

**THE CHOSEN SEASON TWO SERIES**

Set in first century Galilee, the first season chronicles how Jesus starts to build a group of disciples and His ministry. As He performs His first miracles, including turning water into wine in Cana, and invites people of various backgrounds to study under Him, Jesus calls the redeemed woman Mary Magdalene; the stonemason Thaddaeus; the choir member Little James; the fishermen Simon, Andrew, Big James, and John; the caterer Thomas and vintner Ramah; and the tax collector Matthew to follow Him. Following Jesus’s meeting with the Pharisee Nicodemus, the season culminates with the group traveling through Samaria, where Jesus launches public ministry after revealing to Photina, a Samaritan woman.

**THE VATICAN NEWS FEED**

We’d like to draw your attention to a new item on the Diocese of Columbus website (<https://columbuscatholic.org/>), the Vatican News Feed. Bishop Fernandes has worked with the Dicastery of Communications in Rome and the Catholic Foundation to be able to provide this free news service to the Diocese of Columbus. The Vatican feed is divided into three parts and will contain: 1) Videos constantly and automatically updated featuring Pope Leo XIV, 2) A news ticker about the pope, the Holy See, and the Universal Church, constantly and automatically updated, 3) The link to access Vatican.va, the official website of the Holy See with the pope’s full texts. The feed features articles with reports on the pope and on the main events that take place in Rome and in the Universal Church, but also a number of materials that can be used for pastoral work, education, and prayer. This service will thus make it possible to strengthen the communion of American dioceses and parishes as well as all the dioceses and parishes worldwide with the Successor of Peter, a pressing need today, especially in the era of fake AI generated content. The Vatican considers this initiative important and urgent also, in view of the fact that the pontiff’s mother tongue is English and, for the first time in history, the Pastor of the Universal Church is a citizen of the United States. You may have already noticed the feed on both the Diocese of Columbus and *The Catholic Times* websites.

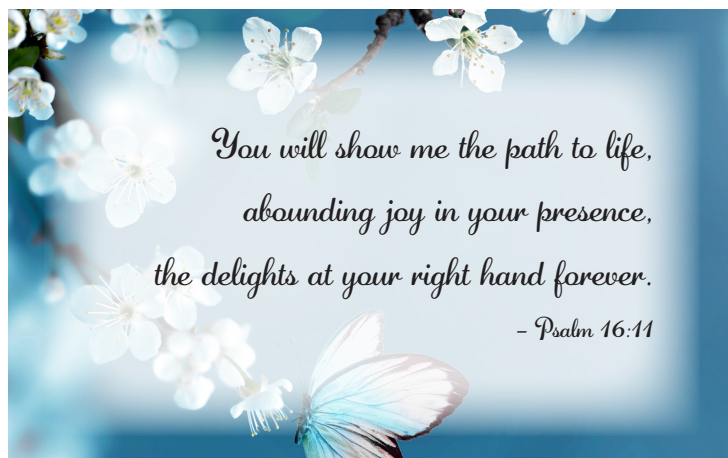

### SAINT ANSELM

*Saint of the Day: April 21 • Patron Saint of Theologians, Philosophers, and Benedictine Monks*

Indifferent toward religion as a young man, Anselm became one of the Church's greatest theologians and leaders. He received the title "Father of Scholasticism" for his attempt to analyze and illumine the truths of faith through the aid of reason.

At 15, Saint Anselm wanted to enter a monastery, but was refused acceptance because of his father's opposition. Twelve years later, after careless disinterest in religion and years of worldly living, he finally fulfilled his desire to be a monk. He entered the monastery of Bec in Normandy, was elected prior three years later, and 15 years later, was unanimously chosen abbot.

Considered an original and independent thinker, Anselm was admired for his patience, gentleness, and teaching skill. Under his leadership, the Abbey of Bec became a monastic school, influential in philosophical and theological studies.

During these years, at the community's request, Anselm began publishing his theological works, comparable to those of

Saint Augustine. His best-known work is the book *Cur Deus Homo* ("Why God Became Man").

Against his will, Anselm was appointed archbishop of Canterbury in 1093, at age 60. His appointment was opposed at first by England's King William Rufus and later accepted. Rufus persistently refused to cooperate with efforts to reform the Church.

Saint Anselm finally went into voluntary exile until Rufus died in 1100. He was then recalled to England by Rufus' brother and successor, Henry I. Disagreeing fearlessly with Henry over the king's insistence on investing England's bishops, Anselm spent another three years in exile in Rome.

His care and concern extended to the very poorest people. Opposing the slave trade, Anselm obtained from the national council at Westminster the passage of a resolution prohibiting the sale of human beings.

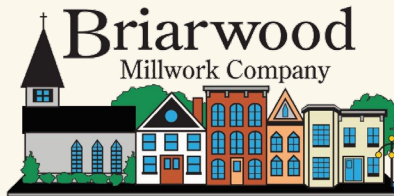

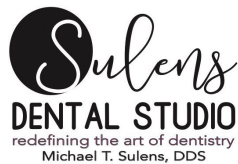
