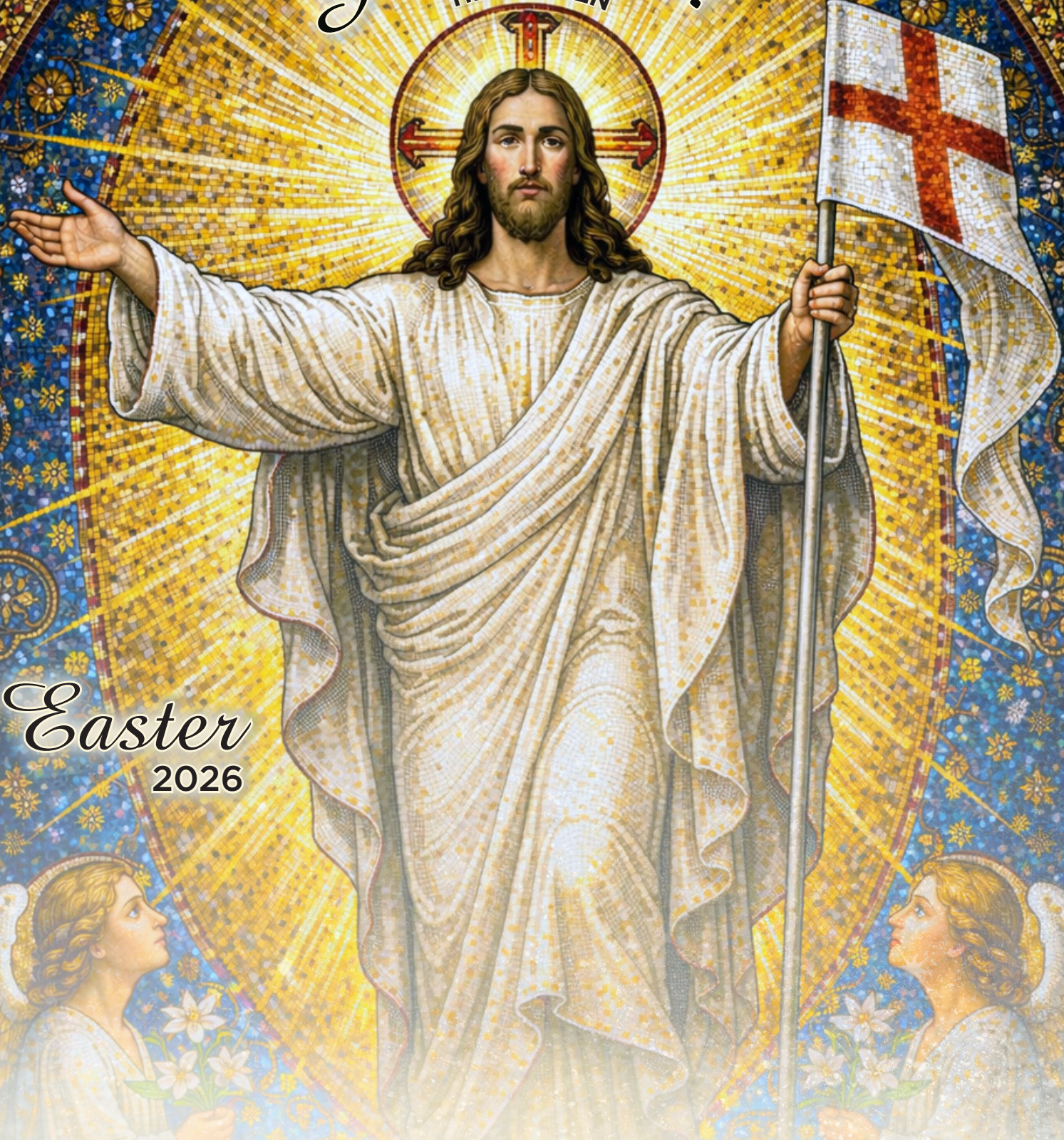

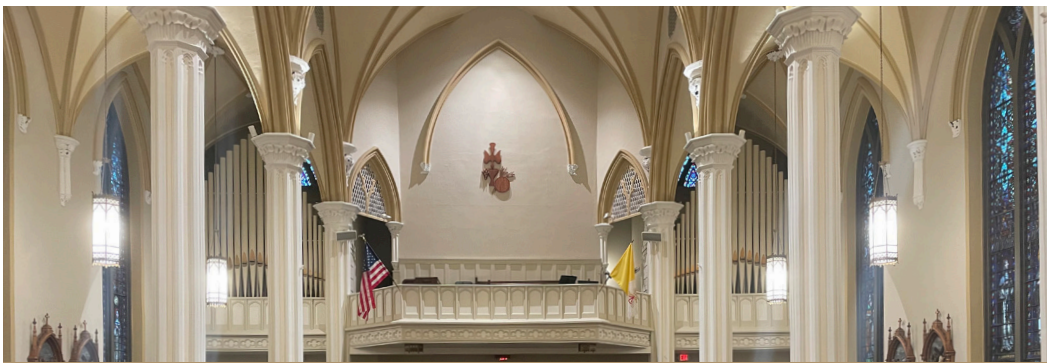

PIVOTAL PLAYERS PREMIERE SESSION:

St. Thomas Aquinas – The Theologian. The relationship of faith and reason is under intense scrutiny in an age beholden to the competing claims of fundamentalism and secularism. So-called “new atheists” insist that the claims of religion amount to mere superstition, a retrograde holdover from a time long ago. Others insist that the life of faith is a retreat into emotions and subjectivism. St. Thomas Aquinas anticipated these objections and trends and demonstrated that to believe is to think and that the life of the mind is integral to life in Christ.

THE CHOSEN SEASON TWO SERIES

Set in first century Galilee, the first season chronicles how Jesus starts to build a group of disciples and His ministry. As He performs His first miracles, including turning water into wine in Cana, and invites people of various backgrounds to study under Him, Jesus calls the redeemed woman Mary Magdalene; the stonemason Thaddaeus; the choir member Little James; the fishermen Simon, Andrew, Big James, and John; the caterer Thomas and vintner Ramah; and the tax collector Matthew to follow Him. Following Jesus’ meeting with the Pharisee Nicodemus, the season culminates with the group traveling through Samaria, where Jesus launches His public ministry after revealing Himself to Photina, a Samaritan woman.

SAINT ROSE VENERINI

Saint of the Day: May 7 | Patron Saint of Catholic Teachers and Educators

Rose Venerini was born at Viterbo in Italy, the daughter of a doctor. Following the death of her fiancé, she entered a convent, but soon returned home to care for her newly widowed mother. Meanwhile, Rose invited the women of the neighborhood to recite the Rosary in her home, forming a sort of sodality with them.

As she looked to her future under the spiritual guidance of a Jesuit priest, Rose Venerini became convinced that she was called to become a teacher in the world rather than a contemplative nun in a convent. Clearly, she made the right choice: She was a born teacher, and the free school for girls she opened in 1685 was well received.

Soon the cardinal invited her to oversee the training of teachers and the administration of schools in his diocese of Montefiascone. As Rose's reputation grew, she was called upon to organize schools in many parts of Italy, including Rome. Her disposition was right for the task as well, for Rose often met considerable opposition but was never deterred.

She died in Rome in 1728, where a number of miracles were attributed to her. She was beatified in 1952 and canonized in 2006. The sodality, or group of women she had invited to prayer, was

ultimately given the rank of a religious congregation. Today, the so-called Venerini Sisters can be found in the United States and elsewhere, working among Italian immigrants.

Whatever state of life God calls us to, we bring with us an assortment of experiences, interests and gifts – however small they seem to us. Rose's life stands as a reminder that all we are is meant to be put to service wherever we find ourselves.

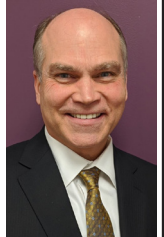

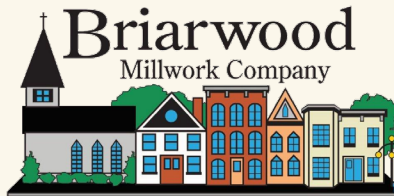

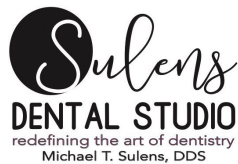
